Parents earn credits by attending **FREE**, locally offered classes (transportation provided when necessary). These credits are then used to purchase new, quality Christmas gifts from our Santa Shoppe.

Participation requirements to earn access for the Santa Shoppe.

If you have **1 child you must attend 4 classes, 2 children 6 classes, 3 Children 8 classes, 4 Children 10 classes, 5 Children 12 classes, 6 Children 14 classes.** You are asked to earn all of your credits within **30 Days** of applying.

Once you have returned your application you can start signing up for classes.

Classes are offered Monday through Thursday at the Dream Center in Easley from 9:15am -8:00 pm. Classes will also be taking place at the Adult Education Center in Pelzer on Monday and Tuesday from 6-8pm. You must sign up for classes in advance to ensure your spot. Child care and Transportation can be provided if you call **864-774-0072** at least 48 hours in advance. Leave a message with your name, address, and a call back number where you can be reached.

Santa Shoppe opens for shoppers who have completed their class requirements November 17th. Santa Shoppe will be open by appointment on Tuesdays 10 am -5 pm, Thursdays 4pm-8pm, and Saturdays 10 am -2pm through December 17th.
